


New Afrikan Freedom Fighter Day, July 18, 1981 Solidarity Statement from May 19th Communist Organization by Judy Clark





"It was Assata Shakur's Birthday and she's a freedom fighter. She's fighting to free other Black people and she's underground."




Puerto Rican people have a right to their country. For Puerto Rico to be free, it will weaken the u.s. and help us defeat it, too."








