In New York, a grand jury convened on October 6 under the Racketeering Influence and Corrupt Organizations (RICO) Act is trying to smash the armed clandestine forces of the Black Liberation Struggle. By sweeping up activists from the Black Liberation Struggle, the Puerto Rican Independence movement and the white anti-imperialist movement. The state is using the grand jury to get information, to issue indictments, to jail activists, to criminalize political dissent, and to attack mass support for revolutionary struggle. Unable to get at the armed clandestine movements, the government is attacking the mass movement to try and intimidate people from supporting our freedom fighters. The U.S. government understands that like in Vietnam, armed struggle and developing people's war will destroy the empire. Grand juries are the "legal" arm of the state's unfolding strategy against the national liberation struggles.

On October 20th, the Revolutionary Armed Task Force, a formation of Black and white revolutionaries under the leadership of the Black Liberation Army, attempted an expropriation of \$1.6 million from a Brinks truck. While the action itself was unsuccessful, it showed the advances of the Black Liberation Struggle in the alliance and is a clear threat to U.S. imperialist domination. Four freedom fighters -- Solomon Brown, Judy Clark, David Gilbert, and Kathy Boudin were arrested. In the following days and months three other Black revolutionaries were seized and charged -- Sekou Odinga, Abdul Majid, and Kuasi Balagoon.

The Justice Department and FBI are using the action as a pretext to implement a program of wholesale attacks on the New Afrikan Independence Movement and revolutionary anti-imperialist forces. Presently, four people -- Fulani Sunni-Ali, Yaasmin Fula, Gerri Gaines, and Eve Rosahn -- have been subpoenaed to the RICO grand jury and have refused to collaborate. Fulani Sunni-Ali is being sought as a material witness. Ivette Alphonso, an independentista of the PSP as well as five health workers, relatives and friends of the Black Acupuncture Advisory Association of North America (BAAANA) have been subpoenaed as well. The state's terror campaign includes the assassination of Mtyari Shabaka Sundiata by the NYPD; the systematic torture of Solomon Brown and the political isolation of the freedom fighters; and attacks on public political activists and organizations such as in the attack on BAAANA and on Chui (Cecil) Ferguson and Jamal (Eddie) Josephs in their homes.

Since 1977, the revolutionary Puerto Rican Independence Movement and the ChicanoMexicano struggle have fought that non-collaboration is the only strategy to defeat grand jury terrorism. Faced with illegal inquisitions into the FALN and the armed clandestine movements on the island, activists have refused to collaborate with the state and have affirmed public support for the armed struggle. Carlos Noya of La Liga Socialists Puertorriquena and Norberto Cintron Fiallo, revolutionary labor leader, are examples of that resistance. Their principled stand has exposed the grand jury as the weapon of this illegitimate government trying to maintain colonial domination over Puerto Rico. Grand jury resisters have shown the movement that activists are willing to go to jail to protect and defend the armed clandestine movements. In not collaborating they have prevented the U.S. government from issuing any indictments. Out of this struggle a mass resistance movement has been built committed to independence and socialism for Puerto Rico which has won the freedom of Carlos Noya and which has empowered the case of grand jury resister Norberto Cintron Fiallo who was resubpoenaed after his release to heighten the contradictions that exist within the bourgeoisie of colonized Puerto Rico.

Non-collaboration is a strategy that has defeated the grand jury because it is based in the principle of protecting and defending the armed clandestine movements as they fight against imperialism. We refuse to collaborate with the illegitimate U.S. empire that is built off stolen land, genocide of whole nations of people, and the exploitation of all working people. Non-collaboration is a principle that must empower our entire resistance movement. This is particularly crucial for women. There is a tremendous threat posed to the system of imperialism by a powerful, revolutionary women's movement that sees the protection and defense of our freedom fighters as central and strategic in the struggle for full liberation. In the face of our willingness to confront U.S. imperialism, the government is trying to build a women's movement as an arm of the state and is implementing a program to organize women to play an active role in maintaining an increasingly fascist system. Women raise, and socialize the system and run our communities. That is why half of the \$7 billion dollars allocated to the Law Enforcement Assistance Association (LEAA) has been earmarked for programs to organize women and children to work with the police and police agencies. Imperialism is unleashing more and more violence against women at the same time that it builds mass support for the Family Protection Act which will force women back into the home, legalize wife beating, make lesbianism a crime, and make it more impossible for single mothers to survive. National liberation struggles are defeating imperialism. They pose the only strategy for women's liberation. We look to the leadership of women freedom fighters because our liberation will only be won when imperialism is defeated and socialism is built.

Revolutionary organizations in the Puerto Rican, ChicanoMexicano, New Afrikan and white anti-imperialist movements are calling on all anti-imperialist and progressive people to come together at a NATIONAL CONFERENCE AGAINST REPRESSION AND FASCISM in Denver, Colorado May 28-30 to struggle about a unified program to combat repression and fascism and to be part of a winning strategy for liberation.
