### *Who are We?*

The members of the Black Panther Newspaper Committee are located in many cities and states. We were all members of the Black Panther Party who participated in the formation, organization, and day to day operations of Black Panther Party activities in its offices, branches, and chapters across this country. We participated in these activities in capacities from Central Committee Members to Rank-And-File Panthers. We fed children, clothed families, opened free health clinics, and educated children. Many of us were forced into exile, or underground, or were imprisoned by the U.S. government during its COINTELPRO wars. We saw our offices bombed, comrades framed and imprisoned, and consoled the families of those who were killed in illegal attacks on the Panthers and the Afrikan-American community by government agents in an attempt to stop our liberation movement. Some of us are political prisoners and prisoners of war who have been imprisoned for our participation in the Afrikan-American struggle for national liberation for nearly twenty years. We announce to you that we are back!

### *What is Our Goal?*

We have come together because of a compelling need we feel to address the critical issues facing the Afrikan-American community. In the cities where we live, the Afrikan-American community is being destroyed by the plagues of drugs, unemployment, poor, inadequate, or non existant housing, miseducation, and systematic and pervasive institutional racism designed to destroy our community. In the past the *Black Panther*, *Black Community News Service* was an uncompromising voice for exposing these attacks on the Afrikan-American community and for advocating an implacable stand to redress them. We are once again publishing the *Black Panther*, *Black Community News Service*, and we are proud to announce to you that that uncompromising voice has returned!

### *How Can You Assist Us?*

The Black Panther Newspaper Committee operates as a collective with democratic centralism as its basic decision making process. Decisions about the content, editorial policy, distribution, etc, are made collectively.
