What is the role of the White Church in the life of the Black Community? We have been told, "Blacks and Whites must work together, side by side, in a mutual struggle to solve mutual problems." But we have also been told, "Whenever Whites come into the Black community, they try to run things; and the Black Community must establish its own identity and programs that specifically reflect their needs."

These statements seem to be contradictory, but are they? You are invited to a program concerning this question. Speaking, together, will be Robert McAfee Brown, noted Protestant theologian, professor of religion at Stanford University, and long time peace and civil rights activist; and Bobby Seale, recent candidate for mayor of Oakland and leader of the Black Panther Party. Entertainment will be provided by the Intercommunal Youth Band, made up of children between the ages of 6 and 14 years of age.
