The most recent action in San Mateo is the publishing of the condensed version of the 'WHY FREE HUEY' pamphlet. I ran 15,000 at a total cost of \$159. This comes to 1.06¢ each. Last night the County Comm. approved including them in the mailing as well as the two Cleaver 'Black Paper' pamphlets which I got for free. We must distribute the remainder as soon as possible both so as to have the most effect before 6MAY and also so as to maintain the snowballing effect. I have been putting them out on consignment at a penny apiece to people who give them away. I see two ways to raise the publication costs: 1. Pass the hat for the five or seven dollars (500 to 700 copies) among the activists involved or 2. take them on consignment and redistribute in small and large lots to individuals who in turn will pay 25¢ to a dollar (25 to 100) and give them to friends or strangers. In any case we've got to get them out. They're the best thing we've got. The local distributors will be:
