

COMMUNIQUE FROM THE UNITED PEOPLE'S LIBERATION ARMY (TRANSCRIPT)

This communique is addressed to those who bear the hopes and the future of the people. Let your guns express the voices of freedom. I am General Field Marshall Cabrella of the Federated Forces of the Symbionese Liberation Army. I am also a War Council member of the newly formed United Peoples Liberation Army of America (UPLA). This united front of Urban Guerilla Organizations was forged out of an emergency meeting after the events in Los Angeles last week. I have been authorized by the Council to make certain information public from subjects (1), (2), and (3) from this historic meeting. But first I must say to you Tania, Bill, Emily, if you have not received our message through proper channels I say to you, "Regroup, regroup, do nothing in haste--we will unite in time."

Subject Number 1: Meeting of the Federated Forces of the Symbionese Liberation Army with the Guerilla Organizations now under the umbrella of the United Peoples Liberation Army.

Purpose: To honor our heroic SLA Soldiers, to expand our combat unit operations, to coordinate expanded combat unit operations through multiple organizational techniques.

Resolutions:

1. To restructure all active underground forces into combat units of regional and national proportion.
2. To inform all combat units of the Black Liberation Army, the Symbionese Liberation Army, the PAC, the BGF, the VCS and the NWLF to put all combat units on alert.
3. To choose the time and the place for our coordinate assaults. Our regrouping is for the purpose of restructuring techniques. The purpose is for a maximum effect from our coordinated assaults.
4. To add Mandate #17 to our rules of combat. No more than three individuals will occupy a safehouse. Six soldiers are too many comrades to lose in one attack.
5. Issue Mandates 17 to 22 and items 8 to 10 to intelligence units to be coded and distributed to security units for distribution to all Guerilla Organization Combat Units.
6. To call on those who were moved by the example of the SLA Six to embrace our struggle. Form combat units, attack. Your deeds will be recognized and our underground will embrace you.
7. To inform the people that the SLA Six were victims of overkill techniques. The military armed corporate state made examples of them in order to frighten future combatants. It is now our turn to make examples of them. We must become hunters. We will not be frightened. Our guns will express our disfavor. Remember, time is on our side.

All above remember that no more than 15 living comrades have been marked by its honor. We love you Tania. We're moving on to higher ground.
