DEANS, DIRECTORS, DEPARTMENT CHAIRMEN AND ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICERS:

As you probably know, The Regents held a special meeting in Oakland yesterday. They passed the following resolution of University policy:

The Board of Regents declares that it is its firm policy, effective as of today, that University personnel including all levels of faculty and teaching assistants, who participate in any strike or otherwise fail to meet their assigned duties in an effort to disrupt University administration, teaching, or research, will thereby be subject to termination of their employment relationship with the University, denial of re-employment, or the imposition of other appropriate sanctions.

This policy becomes effective today, December 7, 1966. Please insure that every University faculty member and employee within your area of responsibility is made aware as soon as possible of this policy statement.
