Its important to note that since my confinement at SCF, my blood sugars have spiked upwards to 600+ and down as low as 32. Needless to say, both levels are extremely dangerous, and that I have suffered such sugars continuously, since 2011 to the present (2016). Because of my extreme unstableness, it was finally reasoned that an insulin pump was my sole survival opportunity. At the conclusion of my October 12th medical interview, I was informed by the Endocrinologist that he would forward the paper work "immediately" towards approval for the \$6,000.00 insulin pump.

Since that intervention to present, my sugars continue to spike, both up and down. Yet, no word or issuance of insulin pump has occurred. I am concerned why, no word or consult has reached me whether the pump was approved or not. What secondary treatment plan was/is, being considered and/or implimented? Or is this just another outlet of double-speak? A means of, fast forwarding my demise based on medical neglect in the guise of delay, delay, delay?

ACTION REQUESTED: Immediate consult and disclosure of what is planned, when to be implimented and all future aspects of PATIENTS BILL OF RIGHTS be implimented.
