

10th. PERSON SUBPEONAED TO GRAND JURY INVESTIGATING THE PUERTO RICAN INDEPENDENCE MOVEMENT

PAM FADEM - North American Anti-Imperialist activist from Austin, Texas was subpoenaed before the Brooklyn Federal grand jury and refused to testify on February 16. The FBI is "investigating" the FALN bombings of February 28 and December 31, 1982 in New York City. Pam has now been charged with Criminal Contempt and is scheduled to go to trial on May 21, 1984.

APPEAL REJECTED - Five members and supporters of the Movimiento de Liberacion Nacional/Puertorriqueno and the Movimiento do Liberacion Nacional/Mexicano will be jailed on Criminal Contempt because they refused to testify before the same grand jury. The Appeals court said that there is no defense for Criminal Contempt.

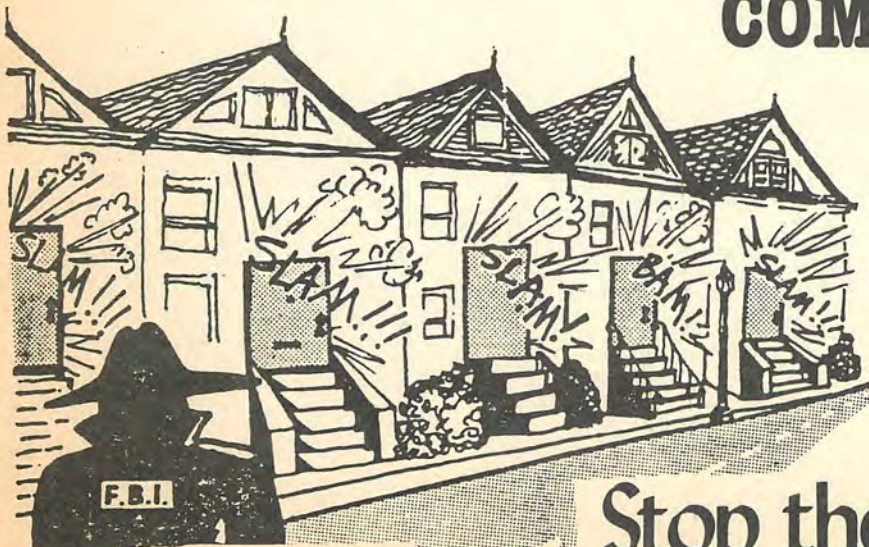
JANUARY 20, 1984 - Shelley Miller of the New Movement in Solidarity with Puerto Rican Independence and Socialism and Silvia Baraldini of the May 19th Communist Organization were convicted for refusing to testify before the grand jury. They will be sentenced on March 16, 1984 before Judge Sifton.

APRIL 6, 1984 - Carlos Noya Muratti of La Liga Socialista Puertorriquena and the organization's representative to the CUCRE (Unitary Committee Against Repression) and Federico Cintron Fiallo, national spokesperson for the CUCRE, will be sentenced on Criminal Contempt charges (April 6 before Judge Nickerson) because they too refused to speak to the grand jury. Broad sectors of the Puerto Rican nation will be testifying on their behalf.
