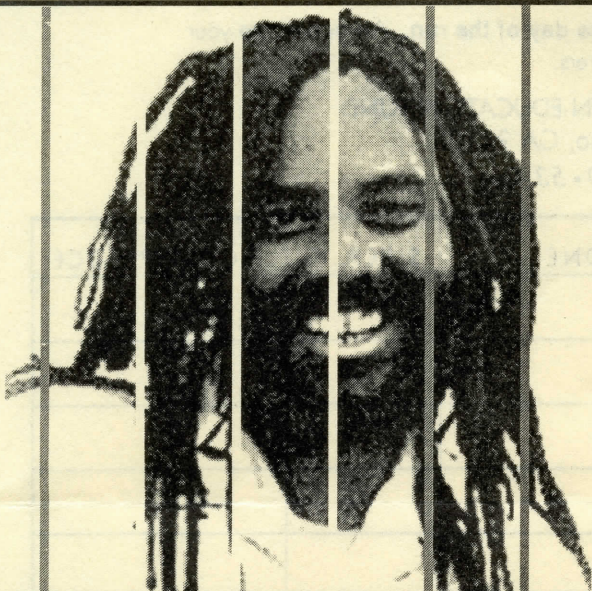


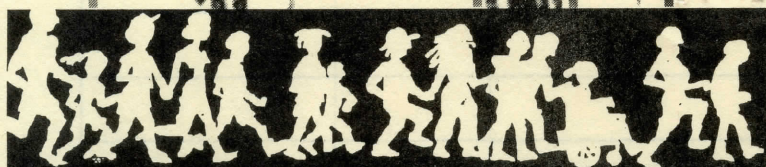
RUN AGAINST RACISM RUN FOR FREEDOM



FREE MUMIA ABU JAMAL JOURNALIST, ACTIVIST ON PENNSYLVANIA DEATH ROW

Mumia Abu Jamal is a human rights activist and former president of the Black Journalist's Association of Philadelphia. Known as the "voice of the voiceless," Mumia was targeted by the government because of his work in Black and poor communities. In 1982 he was wrongly convicted of killing a police officer, and has been on Pennsylvania's death row ever since. Amnesty International and other progressive groups have condemned the U.S.'s racist use of the death penalty.

The U.S. government refuses to recognize the existence of the more than 200 political prisoners in its prisons. In contrast, thousands of political prisoners have been released in South Africa, where the world has just witnessed the first non-racial democratic elections in the country's history. Join us in this walk and run for freedom. Help save the life of an innocent man—Mumia Abu Jamal.
