Notes on Specific Organizations:

Organization of Iranian People's Fedai Guerrillas (OPIFG): The OPIFG was an Iranian Marxist-Leninist organization formed from two communist groups (Jazni-Zarifi and Ahmadzadeh-Pouyan) in 1971 to overthrow the dictatorial Pahlavi regime (commonly referred to as the Shah). At its inception and in the eight years that followed, the group was a major proponent of armed revolutionary struggle and embraced guerrilla war tactics. The OPIFG played an integral role in the 1979 Islamic Revolution in Iran and were subjected to harsh repression and targeted attacks under Pahlavi. As political repression in Iran escalated towards the latter half of the 70s, many OPIFG members began to question the effectiveness of armed tactics, eventually leading to an organizational split in 1979. The majority of the organization's members decided to abandon armed methods and became the OPIFG Majority. Those who remained in support of the line of guerrilla warfare broke away from the OPIFG Majority, forming the OPIFG Minority, or the Iranian People's Fedai Guerrillas (IPFG).

People's Mojahedin of Iran (PMOI): The People's Mojahedin Organization of Iran (PMOI), also known as Mujahedin-e-Khalgh (MEK), is the largest and longest-standing Iranian opposition group founded in 1965. The PMOI/MEK is part of the National Council of Resistance of Iran (NCRI), a large coalition of dissidents and organizations that support western styled democratic regime change in Iran. The organization has been banned in Iran since 1981.

National Council of Resistance of Iran (NCRI): A political coalition which seeks an end to religious dictatorship and promotes a secular and western styled democratic Iran based on its platform. The coalition was founded by Massoud Rajavi of PMOI in July, 1981 and is primarily based in Europe.

Committee for Artistic and Intellectual Freedom in Iran (CAIFA): CAIFA began as an ad hoc coalition formed to protest the arrest and torture of the prominent poet and literary critic, Dr. Reza Baraheni. In 1973, Dr. Baraheni was seized by the secret police shortly after publishing an article that criticized the suppression of the Azarbaijani nationality by the Pahlavi regime. Public pressure contributed to his eventual release, however arrests targeting dissidents and oppositional voices continued under Pahlavi, making apparent the need for an ongoing organization to publicize the cases of intellectuals and artists victimized by the Iranian government and to defend the rights of victims. CAIFA was thus formed for the purpose of: working for freedom of artistic and intellectual expression in Iran, bringing the issues of the defense of victimized artists and intellectuals in Iran to public attention, and raising funds for legal and publicity expenses.
